

Pre-Trip Checklist & Suggested Items

Montreal - Quebec City May 20-23, 2024

Luggage: Each person is permitted FREE of charge the following:

1 Checked bag*

Weight: Up to 50 lb

*See First item below for recommendation

1 Carry-on Standard Article

Size: 15.5 x 9 x 21.5 in

No weight limit

Examples:

Small suitcase (including wheels), backpack

1 Carry-on Personal Item

Size: 17 x 6 x 13 in

No weight limit

Examples:

Briefcase, purse, camera bag, laptop computer

- Luggage recommendation: We strongly suggest that you pack as light as possible and do not check a large suitcase at the counter (ok if you must).

We suggest the Carry-on, rolling, small suitcase with wheels listed above. The jet is a regional jet. This bag can be checked at the door of the plane.

On arrival in Canada the bag is picked up right outside the door of the plane, not at baggage claim

- Photocopy or PDF scan** (for email) of your passport, phone numbers to your credit card companies, calling cards, etc. (in case of loss or theft), prescriptions, important USA personal telephone numbers, etc.

- Photocopy/scans** of items above to leave home with family member or friend (Keep in a secure place)

- Back-up ID** - driver's license (keep separate from passport)

- General trip info papers/ or copies on you phone

- Travel alarm clock (or cell phone)

- Clothing according to weather:**
Day high temp is 60-65 F and night time lows are 41 F. Jacket with inside zippered pocket for evening to secure money etc. Sweater /Layers to remove during the day. Men: Long pants. Ladies: Shouders covered for churches. Business casual is ok

- Credit Card(s) - Master Card, Visa or Amex **(Advise bank you will be in Canada)**

Debit Card / ATM Card

(Best way to get Canadian Cash.

Advise bank you will be in Canada)

- DO I NEED CANADIAN CASH?** All purchases can be made with a Debit or Credit Card. Only Cash needed would be for Church basket donations and TIPS for guides and bus driver. **U.S. Cash is OK.**

- Medicines
(A supply of prescription medications; a small supply of your personal choice in over the counter medicines such as Advil, cold remedies etc)

- One change or partial change of clothing and small supply of **personal items in your carry-on bag** in case of checked luggage problem

- Misc. Small travel umbrella, camera, (small lock for suitcase only if TSA approved), mini first aid kit etc.

- Cell phone.** All carriers work in Canada. Check with your carrier regarding any additional charges especially for data. Many carriers now include Canada in your plan

- Cell phone charger**
Note: Electricity in Canada is the same as the U.S. No adapters needed
